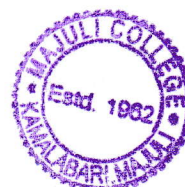


MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

1. Preface:

One of the main objectives of higher education is to provide quality education to students and make them responsible citizens for the development of our society. This type of objective will be achieved if the institutions with similar aims and objectives come closer to share information and resources with each other for better growth and transformation. Collaborative activities will definitely help to identify the shortcomings, drawbacks and remedial measures. Thus, both the colleges intend to collaborate with each other for the improvement of the students, community and society.

Majuli College which was established on September 17, 1962 is the premier institution of higher education situated at Kamalabari in Majuli, the only island district of Assam. Affiliated to Dibrugarh University, Majuli College has been imparting education at the Under Graduate level in both Arts and Science streams. While the Arts stream has been functioning since inception, the Science stream was started in the year 1978 and it came under Deficit Grants in Aid system in 1986. Presently, the college has 10 (ten) departments in Arts stream and 5 (five) departments in Science stream. Offering both Higher Secondary and Degree courses to about 1400 students per year, The college offers P.G. courses in Distance Learning Mode under Dibrugarh University and U.G. and P.G. courses in various subjects under Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University. Other than these, the college offers vocational courses for the benefit of the students in Tourism, Journalism, Computer Applications and Social Works at its own discretion. With support and co-operation of a host of dynamic and forward-looking professionals the college vows to leave its indelible imprints on the sands of time.

2. Objectives of MoU:

In particular, this MOU is intended to

- I. Exchange of faculty and students for improving educational environment.
- II. Explore ways to cooperate in education and training.
- III. Encouraging the use of ICT tools for teaching-learning process.
- IV. Acquaint the students with experimental and field research to explore new and innovative areas.
- V. Ensure student exchange to access laboratory for mutual development.
- VI. Improve communication, co-operation and innovative ideas among students.


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- VII. Facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities.
VIII. Explore the possibilities for developing joint research and collaborations.



3. Functionaries:

For proper implication:

1. Each department will constitute a committee to monitor and evaluate the functions of MoU.
2. A senior teacher will be designated as Liaison officer for monitoring the committee.
3. Both the Liaison officer will prepare an annual plan with the consultation of the head of the institutions.
4. The Liaison officer will have to submit a report annually to the head of the institutions and Head of the institutions will produce that report to the committee constituted for monitoring the function.

4. Scope of the MoU:


1. Both departments believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
2. Both departments will emphasise on teaching and training methodology.
3. The interaction between the two departments will give an insight into the latest developments of the syllabus/course.

5. Period of MoU:

1. The validity of the agreement is three years from the date of commencement.
2. After satisfactory completion of three years, agreement may be extended to next period.
3. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

6. Declaration:

The provisions cited in the above MoU are thoroughly discussed and reached at the consensus that both the institutions will follow the provisions and strive collectively towards effective implementation of the same.
