Preface:

One of the main objectives of higher education is to provide quality education to students and make them responsible citizens for the development of our society. The type of objective will be achieved if the institutions with similar aims and objectives come closer to share information and resources with each other for better growth and transformation. Collaborative activities will definitely help to identify the shortcoming drawbacks and remedial measures. Thus the college intends to collaborate with each other for the improvement of the students, community and society.

Brahmaputra Degree College was established in the year 1993 (Academic Session 1993-1994) and it is situated at a beautiful landscape between the bank of the river Charikoria and mighty Brahmputra in the rural sub-division of Dhakuakhana P.O – Bakulguri, district of North Lakhimpur (Assam). Pin- 787055. It is one of the premier institutions of Higher Education. Covering almost Five (5) Gram Panchayats of Dhakuakhana Sub-Division, where most of the people basically belong to ST.SC.OBC and MOBC. Since its inception, the college has been imparting higher education and providing knowledge and skill among the students of Arts Stream. The college is situated in the Bakulguri region at a distance of about seven(7) kilometers from Dhakuakhana town. The place where the college is situated enjoy a unique position in the field of art. literature and culture. The diverse tribes with their distinct dialects, customs, traditions and culture also make this area a variable paradise for the study of Art and Culture.

The college which began with a few number of students in B.A. 1st year classes consisting of only nine faculty members, is now a full-grown one in the rural Sub-division of Dhakuakhana. The Strength of faculty members has now increased up to twenty six with sufficient academic degrees. The student enrolment of this college is more than 300 at present pursuing B.A courses in arts.

Objectives of MoU:

In particular, this MoU is intended to -

1. Exchange of faculty and student for improving educational environment
2. Assist the student in establishing various start-ups
3. Facilitated effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities
4. Encouraging the use of ICT tools for teaching and learning process
5. Exchange academic materials and information
6. Improve communication, Co-operation and innovative ideas among the students
7. Explore the possibilities of developing joint research, programme and Collaborations
8. Explore ways to cooperate in education and training

Functionaries:

For proper implementation -

1. Each institute will constitute a committee to monitor and evaluate the functions of MoU.
2. A senior teacher will be designated as Liaison officer for monitoring the committee.
3. Both the Liaison officer will prepare an annual plan with the consultation of the head of the institution
4. The Liaison officer will have to submit a report annually to the head of the institutions and Head of the institutions will produce that report to the committee constituted for monitoring the function.

Scope of the MoU:

1. Both institutions believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge
2. Both institutions will emphasize on teaching and training methodology
3. The interaction between the two colleges will give an insight into the latest development of the syllabus/course

Period of Agreement:

1. The validity of the agreement is three (3) years from the date of commencement of MoU.
2. After satisfactory completion of three years, agreement may be extended to next year
3. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

Declaration:


The provisions cited in the above MoU are thoroughly discussed and reached at the consensus that both the institutions will follow the provisions and implement the same by heart and soul.


