## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### BACKGROUND OF THE PARTIES:

Dhakuakhana College in the District of Lakhimpur, Assam (India) was established in 1966 by way of public donations. It envisages social transformation through higher education and community reach out programs. The History of the college is a reflection of keen and earnest desire of the people of Dhakuakhana where most of the inhabitants are belonging to the underprivileged sections of the society viz. the Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes and Other backward classes. The college is affiliated to the Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh and recognized by the UGC under sections 2(f) and 12(B).

The college was taken under Deficit system of Grant in Aid in 1975 and brought under the provincialised system by the Government of Assam in December 2005. It offers undergraduate courses in Science and Humanities having sixteen teaching departments. It also runs a Bio-Tech Hub and a study centre under the Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University (KKHSOU). The permanent faculty strength of the college is forty nine and that of non-teaching staff is twenty four. The present students' enrollment is more than one thousand (including H.S Classes). It has a huge pool of bright alumni that includes a good numbers of university rank holders: quite a few of them occupying prominent position in public life. The 14.95 acre big campus is having the requisite infrastructures- the administrative building, well equipped Library and classrooms, laboratories, playground, Boys and Girls Hostel, the canteen and other basic amenities.

The institution believes in establishing new courses to equip students in the changing scenario and to meet the need of the local society. The college organizes various community reach out programs through its NSS Unit and other forums, collaborates NGOs and civic forums. It aims to introduce courses on entrepreneurship development and looking forward to partner with the industry and other entrepreneurs.

In keeping with the emerging trend of higher educational institutions forming fusion with various significant organizations, Dhakuakhana College has synthesized with the 'Ganabandhu' to carry out a series of activities to create consciousness about health and hygiene, social responsibility and to encourage to uplift deprived sections of the society.

### **GANABANDHU**

Ganabandhu is a registered NGO under Societies Registration Act XXI 1860. It is an NGO basically work for the wellbeing of the deprived classes and environmental conservation and sustainable development. They have organised various discussion through seminars, conferences and workshops. Some of campaigns conducted by Ganabandhu are:

### **PURPOSE OF MOU:**

2. To create awareness on health and hygiene among students and local community.
3. To engage students in this massive drive for sustainable development and eco-friendly ambience.
4. To create awareness among the masses about their responsibility towards environment and ecological balance.
5. To provide information regarding health and hygiene

This MOU is signed between Ganabandhu and Dhakuakhana College for the academic year 2020-23 for the following deliverables:

#### **Deliverables from the Ganabandhu:**

1. Collaborate in organising activities relating to health, hygiene and environment.
2. Help college to promote sustainable development.
3. Help to work for deprived classes

#### **Deliverables from the Dhakuakhana College:**

### *Functionaries:*

### *Responsibilities:*

The two parties recognised that the implementation of any agreed upon activity will depend upon the interest and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources, space and other resources. Any financial commitment for the joint activities under this MOU shall be subject to the approval by the competent authorities of the respective organisations.

## DURATION AND OPTION FOR EXTENSION:


The MoU will become effective when signed by both parties. The agreement will remain in force for three years from the date of signature provided below. It may be renewed or amended by mutual agreement of the parties.
