1. Preface:

One of the main objectives of higher education is to provide quality education to students and make them responsible citizens for the development of our society. This type of objective will be achieved if the institutions with similar aims and objectives come closer to share information and resources with each other for better growth and transformation. Collaborative activities will definitely help to identify the shortcomings, drawbacks and remedial measures. Thus, both the parties intend to collaborate with each other for the improvement of the students, community and society in the field of research.

Assam Science Society is a leading Non-governmental organization of the state of Assam dedicated to the activities like-to build up scientific temper amidst the society, eradication of superstitious believes, biodiversity monitoring and conservation, conservation of wetlands, peoples participation and awareness towards environment, climate issues, research and publication of database of local flora and fauna and also other natural resources, research on diverse fields related to the State of Assam etc. It was established in 1953 and registered under society registration act XXI OF 1860 (No.49 of 1960-61). The Dhakuakhana branch of the organization is established in the year of 1986 on 13th September. Presently, this branch is recognized as a most active branch of the state.

2. Objectives of MoU:

In particular, this MOU is intended to.

- I. Conduct awareness programmes on environment related activities like-biodiversity monitoring and conservation of wetlands in the localities.
- II. Make aware the students and local people about the environmental issues.
- III. Acquaint the students with experimental and field research to explore new database of local flora and fauna
- IV. Build up a scientific temper amidst the society, eradication of superstitious believes.

3.Functionaries:

For proper implication:

1. Each party will constitute a committee to monitor and evaluate the functions of MoU.
2. A senior teacher/official will be designated as Liaison officer for monitoring the committee.
3. Both the Liaison officers will prepare an annual plan with the consultation of the head of the institutions.
4. The Liaison officer will have to submit a report annually to the head of the institutions and Head of the institutions will produce that report to the committee constituted for monitoring the function.

4.Scope of the MoU:


1. Both the parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance awareness and knowledge.
2. Both parties will emphasise on environmental issues.
3. Conduct of awareness programmes by both the parties will give an insight into the latest scientific activities in the localities.


5.Period of MoU:


1. The validity of the agreement is three years from the date of commencement.

3. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.


6.Declaration:
