Concept Note:

Research is the systematic method consisting of enunciating the problem, formulating a hypothesis, collecting and analysing the data and reaching certain conclusions either in the form of solutions or in certain generalisations for some theoretical formulation. Now a day ethical issues in any research much more significant as it protect human participants and serves interests of individuals, groups and society as a whole. Research ethics in the social sciences presents a different set of issues than those in other research. There are many ethical issues to be taken into serious consideration for research. Therefore, this workshop consists of series of interactive sessions on research ethics by experts from premier institutes of the country who will be delivering lectures on recent trends in ethical issues and academic writing in social sciences. The purpose of the workshop is to enable the participants from different disciplines to develop an understanding and provide them a comprehensive overview of framework of research ethics, database, research metrics, steps in academic writing and publication policies. The sessions designed for the workshop will facilitate the participants to identify the predatory publishers and journals, idea of scientific misconduct and redundant publication in social science research. This will strengthen their faculties to develop and contribute meaningful research publications. Researchers, teachers and practitioners across disciplines will benefit from this workshop as it encompasses most relevant ethical issues in academic writing in social science research.

Objectives

The objectives of the workshop are:

to enable participants to understand the ethics in social science research;

to introduce them to writing research article;

to acquaint them structure of academic and qualitative writing;

to impart them knowledge on scientific misconduct and redundant publication;

to apprise them about open access publishing and initiatives;

to initiate them with predatory publishers and journals;

to familiarize them with indexing and citations database, Research metrics and

to enhance their skills in references and bibliography in academic writing.

About the Organisers:
