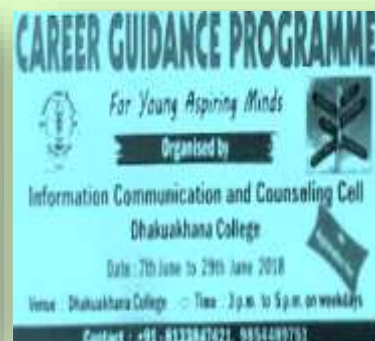

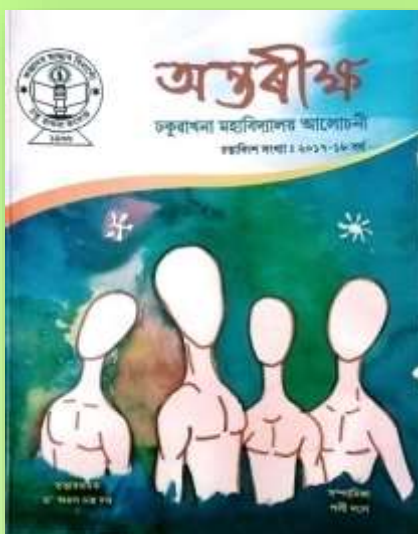


Plan of Action by IQAC/Outcome during the session



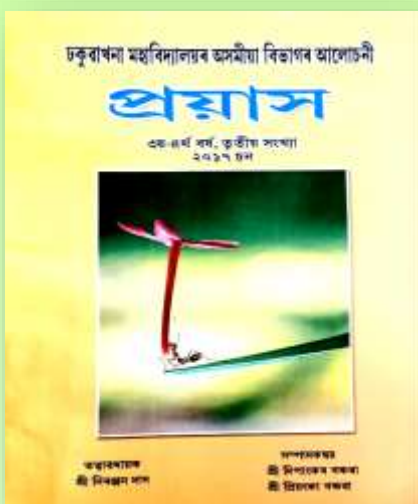
