Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS)

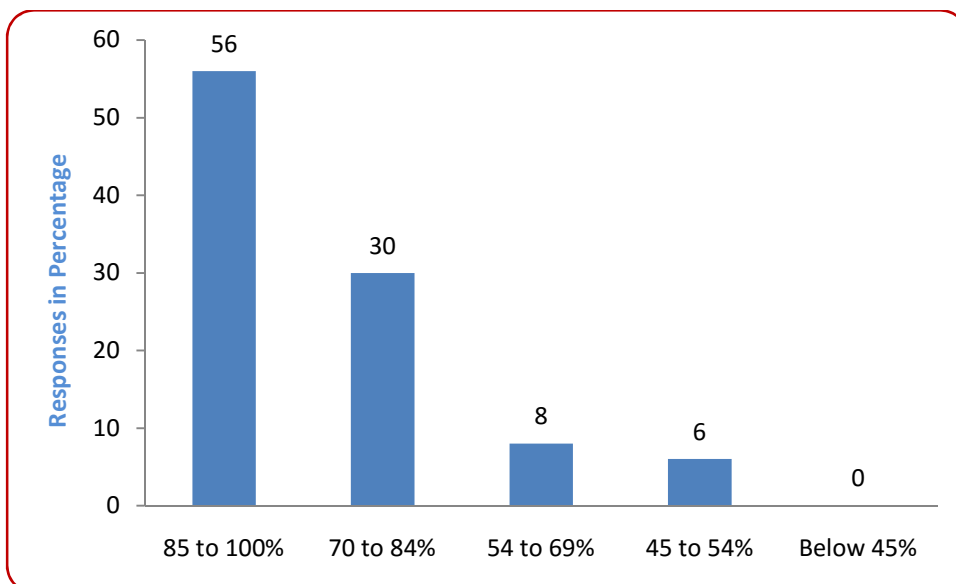
Session: 2020-21

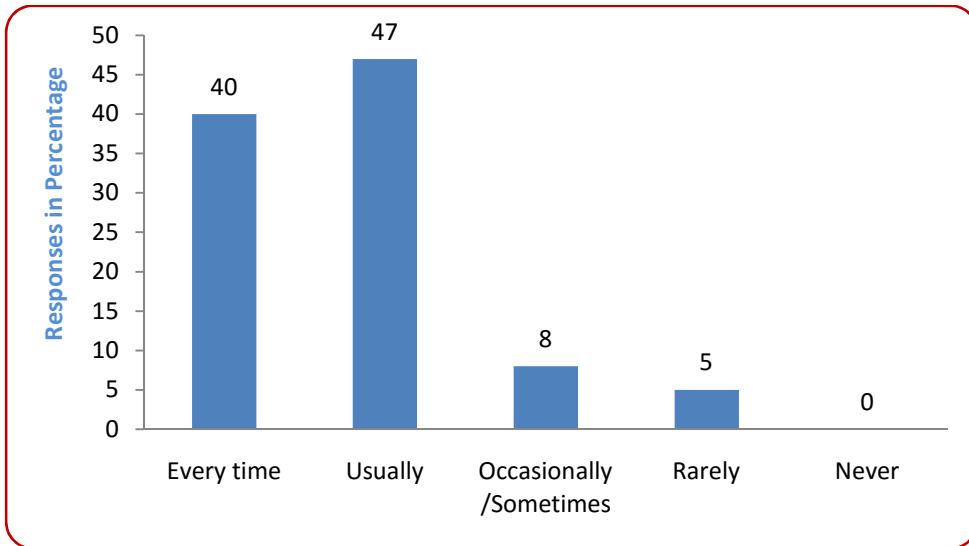
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



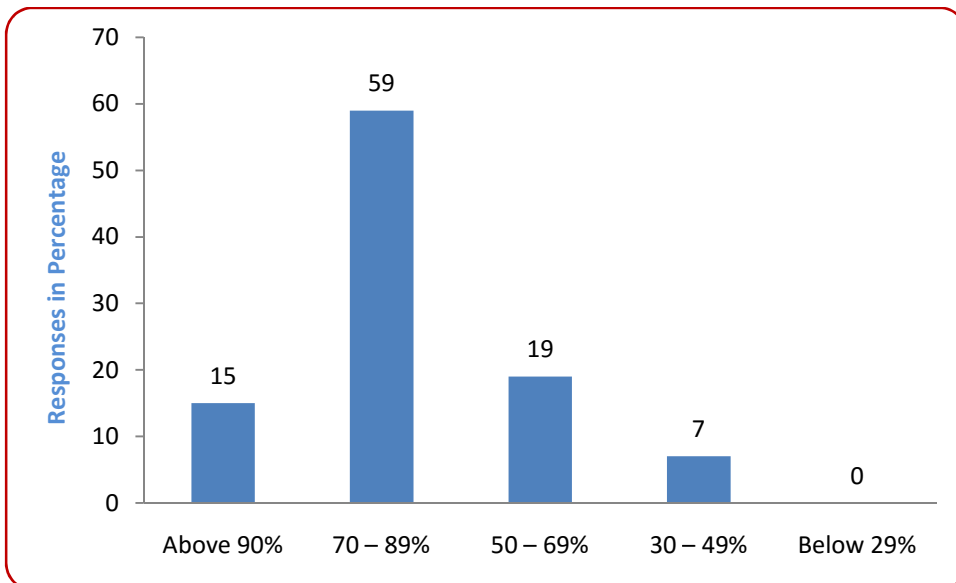
2. The teachers' approach to teaching can best be described as



3. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

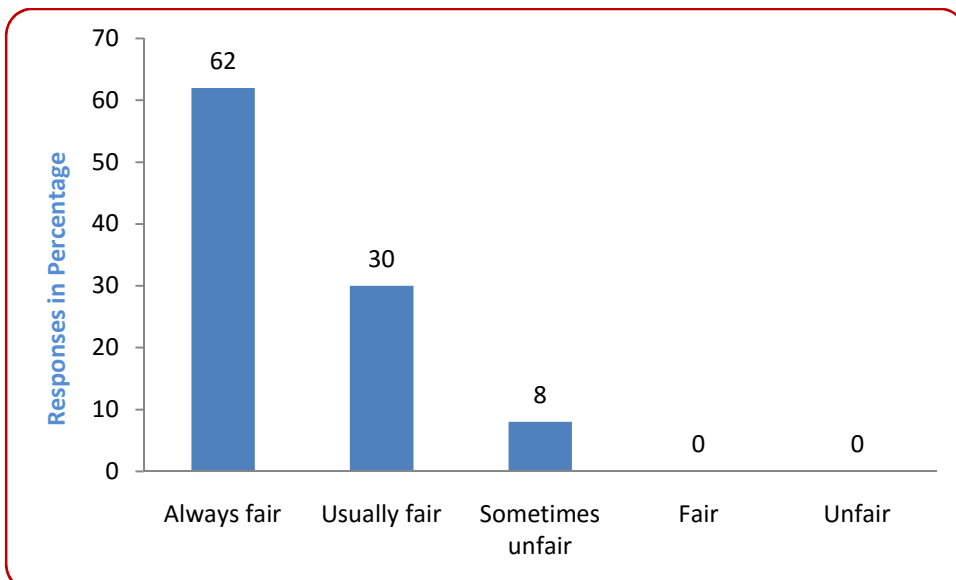


4. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.



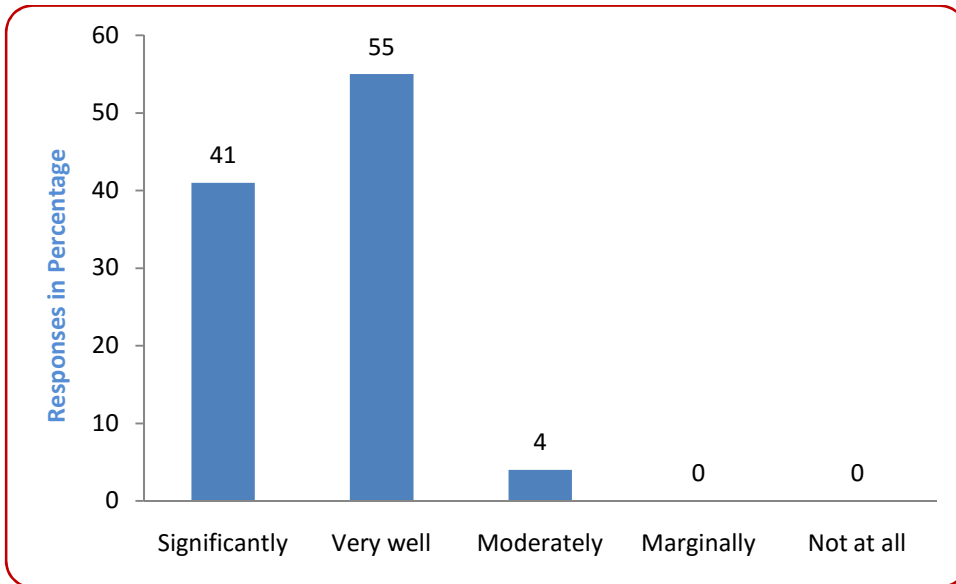
(B) Evaluation

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

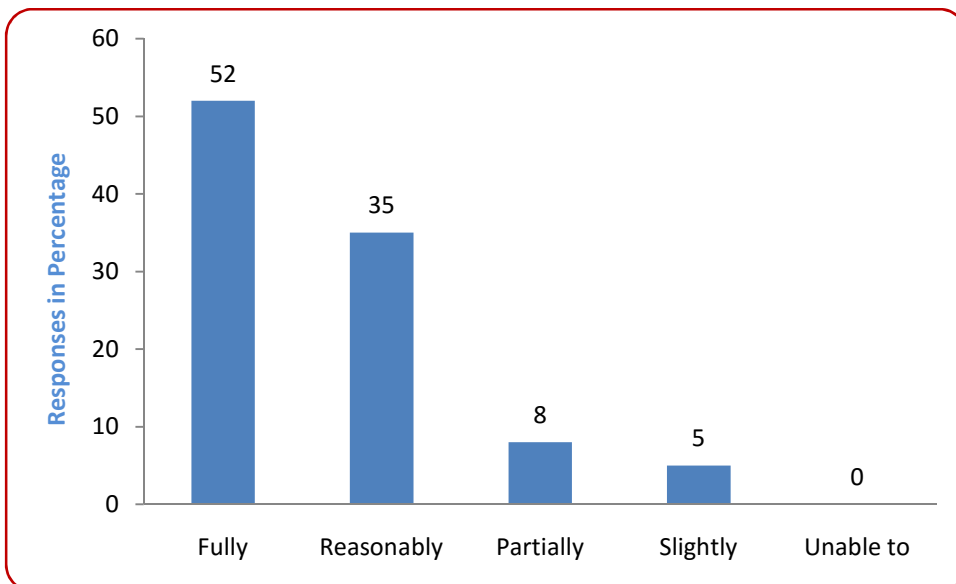


(C) Counseling

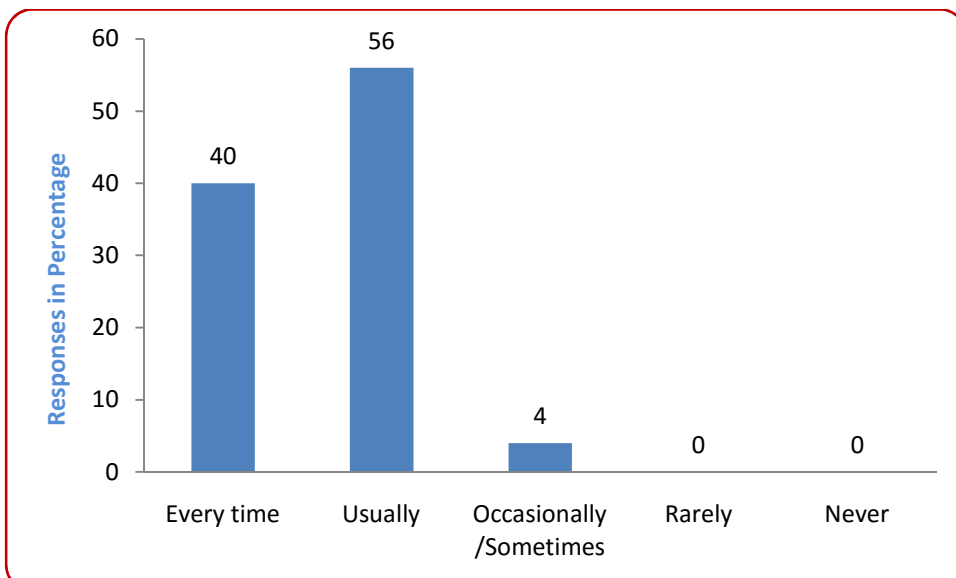
6. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



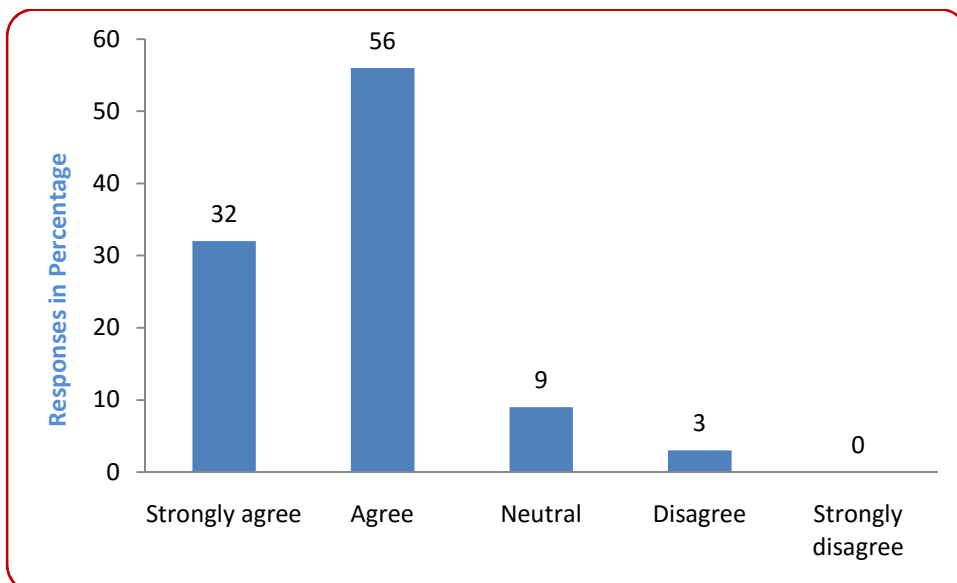
7. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



8. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

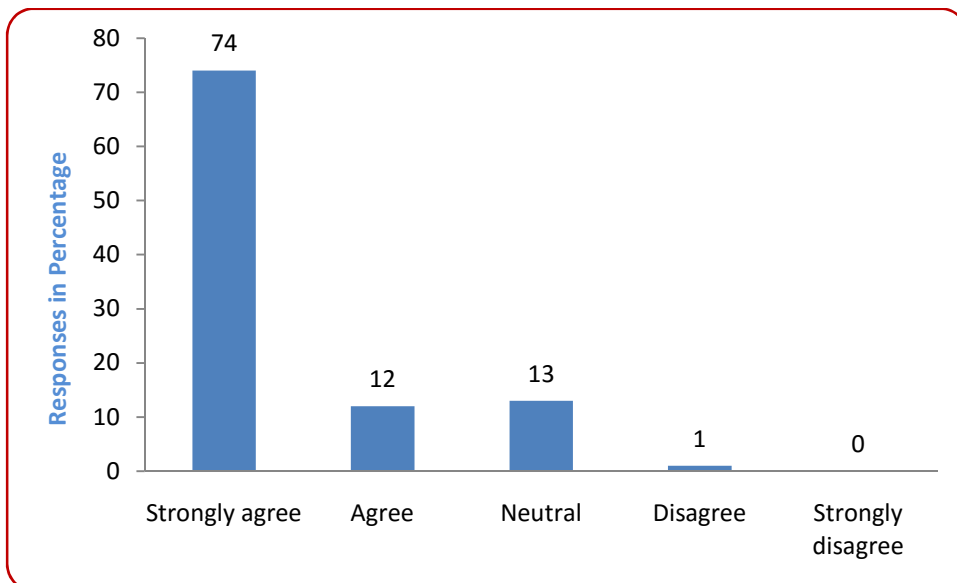


9. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.
